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**Special Presentation on the new High School IEP at LBPSB:**

Presentation by Celina Berube and Patrick O'Connor

The objectives for changing the high school IEP were as follows:

- continuity with elementary IEP - same format and document
- creating SMART goals
  - specific
  - measurable
  - attainable
  - realistic or results oriented
  - time bound
- need for clarity - parents and students should have a clear understanding of goals for each subject
- Need for a common menu of options available to all high schools

Key Features

- Personal supports listed - including tech grant materials
- strategies - common drop down menu options. Strategies are divided into categories
  - o Academic                      Visual                      Auditory
  - o Tactile/Kinesthetic        Social/Behavioural        Exams
- Objectives - common drop down menu options for all subjects using the Ministry's continuum of Learning. .
- Home Communication on Modified IEPs - 10 communications during the school year (at least 1 per month)
- Progress comments are written directly on the IEP for each modified subject
- Option for teachers to write a strategy or objective not listed on the drop down menu

**IEP Parent Representative on Governing Board:**

All schools have now had their AGAs and elected their governing board members. Each school was invited to vote if they would like one of their governing board members be the IEP parent representative on their governing board.
